

ORDINANCE 2005-1

LAKE WASHINGTON SANITARY DISTRICT

THE BOARD OF MANAGERS OF THE LAKE WASHINGTON SANITARY DISTRICT
ADOPTS AND ORDAINS THE FOLLOWING:

Section 1.02 of Ordinance 2003-1 is Amended by restating Subdivision 46 thereof, and by adding Subdivisions 47 and 48 thereto, as follows:

Subd. 46. “Wastewater” means the liquid and water-carried industrial or domestic wastes from dwellings, commercial buildings, industrial facilities, and institutions, together with any *greywater*, groundwater, surface water, and storm water that may be present, whether treated or untreated, which is discharged or permitted to enter the Facilities.

Subd. 47. “Greywater” means sewage that does not contain toilet wastes.

Subd. 48. “Sewage” means waste produced by toilets, bathing, laundry, water treatment devices, water conditioning devices, culinary operations, or any waste derived from any potable water source, or the floor drains associated with these sources.

Section 1.07 of Ordinance 2003-1 is amended by restating Subdivision 4 thereof as follows:

Subd. 4. The owner of any building or property which is located within the District, or any area under the jurisdiction of the District, and from which wastewater is discharged, shall be required to connect to *and discharge all wastewater into* the Facilities, at the owners expenses, within sixty (60) after service of official notice to do so, provided that said public sewer is reasonably available for connection. Additionally, if the building or property is used for human occupancy, employment or recreation, the owner shall be required to install at the same time toilet facilities in accordance with the State Building Code and this ordinance. Said official notice shall be given by the District, or its designated agent, and shall be served upon the owner personally or by certified mail.
