SUBJECT: US Trunk Highway 75 (8th Avenue) DETOUR

Work is progressing on Phase III of the Infrastructure Replacement Project. The City of Madison has requested that the existing watermain along US Trunk Highway 75 be replaced this year. To meet the City's request, the Contractor needs to connect the new watermain to the new water service laterals. In order to accomplish this work, the Contractor is setting up a detour for all nonlocal traffic. It is anticipated the water main and service construction will take up to three weeks, the Contractor plans to begin on Thursday September 24, 2009 for US Trunk Highway 75. The detour will be as follows:

Heading north on US TH 75 (south of MN TH 40)- take a right onto MN TH 40, then head east on MN TH 40 to 1st Avenue, then turn left onto 1st Avenue (CSAH 19) to Lac Qui Parle County Highway 22 then turn left onto Lac Qui Parle County Highway 22 which will bring you back to US TH 75.

Heading south on US TH 75 (north of CSAH 22)- take a left onto Lac Qui Parle County Highway 22 then head east to 1st Avenue (CSAH 19), take a right onto 1st Avenue (CSAH 19) to MN TH 40, then turn right onto MN TH 40 which will bring you back to US TH 75.

We hope to keep the streets open to local traffic and for the local businesses. There may be times in which the Contractor will need to block access on US TH 75 for the public's safety. During these times we are requesting that you use an alternate route around the construction area. All side streets will remain open during the construction on US TH 75. At the end of the construction day, the Contractor plans on having the blocked access on US TH 75 open for local traffic.
