SUBJECT: Utility Construction

---

Work is progressing on the reconstruction project. Underground utility construction is scheduled to start on your street soon. The typical order of work as utility construction proceeds is as follows:

1. Construct sanitary sewer main
2. Construct water main
3. Install sewer and water services (tree removal may be required to replace your service)
4. Switch your house off of the temporary water and onto the new water line
5. Construct storm sewer

The order of work may vary depending on your individual street. Access to your driveway will be maintained to the fullest extent possible during construction, however access will be restricted while work is occurring in front of your property and along the street.

Sewer and water services will be reconstructed as part of the city project from the property line to the sewer or watermain in the street. Homeowners with lead water lines will not be hooked up. Homeowners may elect to have their deficient water & sewer services replaced from the property line to the house as part of the project. These costs may be added to the assessment. If you are not sure if you have a lead water service please contact Jason or Jonas to help determine your service line material.

When the utility work is completed, street reconstruction will occur. We will provide additional information at that time. If you have any questions or concerns at any time, feel free to contact any of the following people:
