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PROJECT UPDATES

Work Along Highway 22

Highway 22 to reopen to traffic from County Road 7 to TH 30 the afternoon of May 8, 2009. The roadway shoulder will continue to be closed off until the utility work and restoration work is completed along Highway 22.

Stormwater pond excavation work near the intersection of Highway 22 and Sixth Ave NE will continue.

Highway 30 – Cemetery To Central Ave

Beginning May 11th, Highway 30 will be closed to traffic from the west end of the project near the cemetery to Central Ave. The Contractor plans to remove sidewalk and concrete pavement beginning near the cemetery and progressing towards Central Ave. Underground utility work will follow and temporary water service lines will be set up.

Highway 30 – Central Ave to Highway 22

Highway 30 from Central Ave to Highway 22 will be open to local traffic only. The blacktop overlay has been removed and the underlying concrete will serve as a temporary driving surface. Please use caution as the road will have a rough surface, but the road will be passable. Work from Third Ave SE to Highway 22 is expected to start after June 1, 2009 once school is out. Work from Central Ave to Third Ave SE is expected to start in middle to late summer.

SAFETY

Construction signage, barricades, cones, and temporary fencing will be used to delineate hazardous areas. However, residents should be aware that construction sites in general are dangerous areas. Obey construction signage and stay away from active construction areas. Please keep children away from the construction zone and out of the project area where construction operations are taking place. Construction personnel with safety vests are much easier to recognize than an unexpected visitor.

Please do not remove the stakes and flags along the project as they mark locations of buried utilities. These stakes and flags are needed so that the contractor can safely excavate.

GARBAGE SERVICE

Garbage service will continue during the project. The Contractor will be coordinating with the garbage service provider or make arrangements for garbage to be picked up.

SERVICE LINE CONNECTIONS

Sewer Service Replacement to House: If residents have decided to hire their own private contractor, they must notify the City by May 14, 2009. Work must be completed by June 1, 2009 if the property is located west of Central Ave and by June 15, 2009 if east of Central Ave.
