PROJECT UPDATES

Construction work is progressing along with work now starting in the last phase of the project. Pavement removals and underground utility work will be taking place from Second Ave NE to Sixth Ave NE, which includes the section of highway near the Mapleton Elevator and Protein Sources. The following is a summary of work completed and expected for the following areas:

Highway 30 – Cemetery to Central Ave

Aggregate surfacing has now been placed on this section of the project. The next major construction work to take place will be grading and placement of curb & gutter.

Highway 30 – Central Ave (CSAH 7) to 2nd Ave NE

The underground utility piping is almost complete and granular roadway materials have been placed for a majority of the area. Final grading of the granular materials will be taking place.

Highway 30 – 2nd Ave NE to 6th Ave NE

Pavement removals will begin in this last section of the project. Street excavation and underground utilities will follow and include installation of mainline sanitary sewer, storm sewer, and watermains. Once the mainline pipe has been installed, the contractor will be following up with the remaining sanitary sewer and water service laterals serving the homes and businesses in this area.

Highway 30 – 6th Ave SE to Highway 22

Street grading work is taking place in this area. The underground utility work is almost complete and granular roadway materials have been placed. In preparation of curb & gutter, placement of the aggregate surfacing will follow in this section next to the school.

SAFETY

As a reminder, please keep children away from the construction zone and out of the project area where construction operations are taking place.

Please do not remove the stakes and flags along the project as they mark locations of buried utilities. These stakes and flags are needed so that the contractor can safely excavate.
