## 2006 Utility & Street Improvements Construction Newsletter

### ◆ SPRING START-UP CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITIES

- ◆ City staff and Contractors Edge, Inc. meet to discuss unfinished work and clean-up items from last years work. Weather permitting, Contractors Edge indicated work could start as soon as the week of April 16<sup>th</sup>. The first item to be addressed will be the yard settlements at and around sewer and water services. Conditions need to be dry in order for this work to effectively be completed. The contractor will then begin to complete other unfinished work.



- ◆ Any settlement in yards resulting from private sewer or water installations should be repaired by the private contractor who originally completed the installations.

- ◆ City staff will inspect the entire project site in the next few weeks to locate and determine corrective action required. This will include but not limited to driveways, sidewalks, landscaping and sod, tree trimming and pavement areas.

- ◆ **In the event of sewer or water emergencies, call 507 665-3338.**

### ◆ PROJECT SAFETY

- ◆ The general contractor, Contractor's Edge is responsible for safety within the construction limits. Construction signage, barricades, cones, and temporary fencing will be used to delineate hazardous areas, however, residents should be aware that construction sites in general are dangerous areas. Obey construction signage and stay away from active construction areas. Parents should remind their children not to play within the construction limits both during and after construction hours.
