2006 Utility & Street Improvements Construction Newsletter

◆ CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITIES

- ◆ Contractors Edge and their sodding subcontractor have begun correcting the service settlements and grading issues in individual lawns. The service areas that have been repaired will continue to be monitored for additional settlement. The concrete subcontractor should be on the jobsite the end of this week to repair any damage to sidewalks, curb & gutter, and driveways. The final layer of bituminous will not be placed on the street until all of the touch-up and repair items have been corrected and all utility testing is complete. Work will continue as weather allows.



- ◆ Any settlement in yards resulting from private sewer or water installations should be repaired by the private contractor who originally completed the installations.

- ◆ City and engineering staff will continue to review the entire project site to locate and determine corrective action required. This will include, but not be limited to, driveways, sidewalks, landscaping and sod, tree trimming and pavement areas. ◆ PROJECT SAFETY

- ◆ The general contractor, Contractor's Edge is responsible for safety within the construction limits. Construction signage, barricades, cones, and temporary fencing will be used to delineate hazardous areas, however, residents should be aware that construction sites in general are dangerous areas. Obey construction signage and stay away from active construction areas. Parents should remind their children not to play within the construction limits both during and after construction hours.
