CURRENT AND UPCOMING WORK

GM Contracting has completed the sanitary sewer, water main, and storm sewer along 2nd Street south of the RR tracks. WW Blacktopping has completed the roadway excavation and sub-drain construction along 3rd Street north of the RR tracks.

Next week, GM plans to finish the remaining underground utility work including the storm sewer along 3rd Street south of the RR tracks, the water main connections to the water tower between 2nd Street and 3rd Street, and the water services along Parkway Avenue. WW Blacktopping plans to haul in aggregate along 3rd Street north of the RR tracks and begin street excavation along 2nd Street south of the RR tracks. The concrete contractor, Curb Masters, is expected to begin installing curb and gutter along 2nd Street north of the RR tracks on Monday.

Access to the alley between 2nd and 3rd Street will be moved to 3rd Street once curb construction begins on 2nd Street. Access to the Eagle's Nest and the Eagle Lake Fitness Center is available off 3rd Street. Parking for Uncle Albert's is available on the south side of the building and along Parkway Avenue and Center Avenue.

CONCRETE CONSTRUCTION

As mentioned above, concrete curb construction will begin next week along 2nd Street north of the RR tracks. After the curb is installed, sidewalk and driveway aprons will follow. Please note that the concrete will need to cure for at least 1 week prior to vehicles being allowed on it. Please avoid driving on, walking on, or touching the fresh concrete.

SCHOOL CROSSING GUARD LOCATIONS

For those residents with children who will be walking to school and need to cross Parkway Avenue, please refer to the attached notice regarding crossing guard locations.

CROSSING GUARD ON PARKWAY AVENUE

With road construction on North 2nd and North 3rd Streets this fall, children will not be able to cross Parkway Avenue at the preferred location of North 3rd St. when school starts.

While construction is occurring on these streets, the crossing guard will be located at the intersection of Parkway Ave and Agency Street.

Once North 2nd Street is completed, the crossing guard will be located at Parkway and 2nd Street.

When North 3rd Street is completed, the crossing guard will return to that intersection, which is the preferred location for crossing Parkway Ave. on the way to and from school.
