

**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARINGS & INFORMATIONAL MEETING  
GREEN LAKE SANITARY SEWER AND WATER SYSTEM DISTRICT  
WASTEWATER COLLECTION SYSTEM IMPROVEMENT HEARING  
FOR DIAMOND LAKE IN KANDIYOHI COUNTY**

Pursuant to Minnesota Statutes 116A.12 and 429.03, notice is hereby given that the Kandiyohi County Board of Commissioners has scheduled a public hearing for proposed Wastewater Collection System for Diamond Lake in Kandiyohi County. The public hearings will discuss the updated Engineer's report based on detailed plans, bid opening results and financing. The public hearing will give all persons an opportunity to comment or otherwise testify on the proposed Wastewater Collection System.

The total estimated project costs of the proposed improvements are \$6,058,200. These improvements are proposed to be assessed against benefited properties within the area of the recently expanded Green Lake Sanitary Sewer and Water System District (GLSSWD) Boundary around Diamond Lake. The main elements of the proposed Wastewater Collection System include 14.0 miles of low-pressure sanitary sewer forcemain, 2 lift stations, and 284 low-pressure sanitary sewer grinder pump stations. The trunk forcemain that was installed during the City of Kandiyohi Wastewater Regionalization Project will be used to connect Diamond Lake to the existing GLSSWD treatment facilities.

The Open House will be held to answer individual property owner questions regarding forcemain and grinder pump location on their property; while the informational meeting is intended to explain and answer questions about construction, timing, the Engineer's report, assessments and other financing in preparation for the public hearing at 7:00 p.m. on May 21, 2010.

DeWolf, P.E., Bolton and Menk, Inc., Engineer for the project, has prepared a "Report on Engineer's Survey and Examination to Kandiyohi County for providing Wastewater Collection System Improvements for Diamond Lake."
