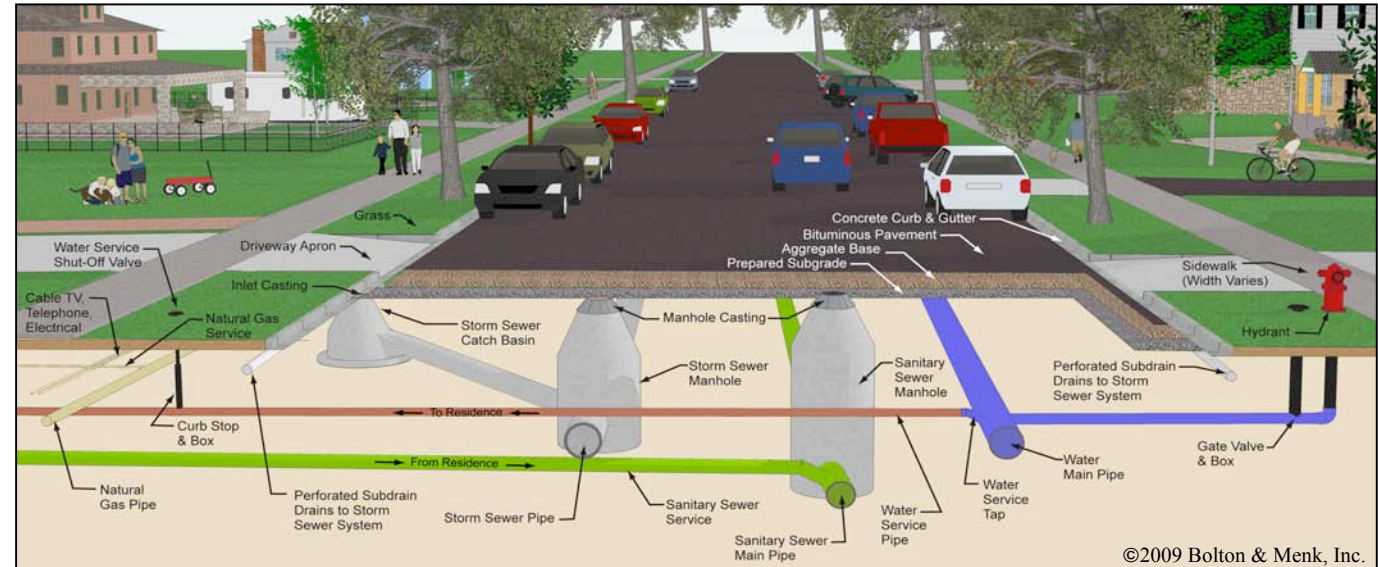
Neighborhood Meeting

There will be a neighborhood meeting held at City hall at **6 pm on Thursday, March 26, 2009** to talk about what to expect, the contractors proposed schedule and to answer any questions the property owners may have.

Project Schedule, Important Information

- March 23: "Road will be closed April 1" signs installed.
- April 1: TH 282 is closed between Creek Lane and TH 21 (Broadway). Contractor begins removing the pavement between the Sand Creek bridge and Wood Street.
- Mid April: Contractor bores 2 casings under the railroad.
- April 13: Signal at TH 282 and TH 21 is shut down. Construction begins in the intersection. Intersection is open to traffic but there will be delays during rush hours due to the 3 way stop for the duration of construction.
- April 28: TH 282 between Mertens Street and Creek Lane will be open to local traffic.

-We have been in contact with the garbage hauler, post office and school bus company. Service is planned to continue as usual.

-Please let Roger know about any invisible dog fences or sprinkler systems you may have in your front yard.

-Property Owners have the option to sign an agreement and have the City's contractor replace their water line from the shutoff at the property line into their home for an additional \$1,415. This is especially beneficial if your existing service is constricted or constructed of lead pipe.
