CITYWIDE INFRASTRUCTURE MANAGEMENT PLAN

Proper planning for city infrastructure projects should include the combined consideration of pavements and underground utilities. An infrastructure management plan will provide a city with information to fully understand their needs and plan for the future. Citywide infrastructure management plans include technical information to prioritize future improvements on a citywide basis along with the associated costs. Consideration of current and future infrastructure needs creates a sound plan that helps you minimize overall costs and construction impacts, with the added benefit of funding readiness.

What is an Infrastructure Management Plan?

An infrastructure management plan offers the benefits of a pavement management plan with information on underground utilities. Once all pavement and utility needs are determined, they can be prioritized and used as a tool for project planning. Infrastructure management plans provide

- Conditional ratings for streets and underground utilities
- Maps and tables summarizing street recommendations for routine pavement maintenance
- Pavement overlays
- Reconstruction based on street conditions, utility conditions, or street and utility conditions combined
- Planning level cost estimates for each street and utility segment

At its most basic level, an infrastructure management plan is a snapshot inventory and assessment of existing streets and utilities. Information from the plan can be used to develop a capital improvement plan and/or aid in developing annual maintenance and improvement budgets that overall reduce both budget and construction impacts.
