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PROJECT UPDATE

You may have noticed that there were some orange road work signs installed within the project area last week, specifically Road Closed signs on Eau Claire and 154th Street. I have received several questions regarding the signs so here is an update to help avoid any confusion.

The signs are pertaining to a different and completely separate emergency construction project, the 2015 County Road 21 Watermain Replacement Project, that will be repairing the existing City owned watermain under the northbound lanes of County Road 21 (Eagle Creek Avenue). This stretch of watermain between Eau Claire Trail and 154th Street (County Road 82) suffered a break during the winter and requires replacement before the high water demand associated with summer begins.

The project is anticipated to start on April 20th and last a maximum of 14 days. In order to complete the project the access to Eau Claire Trail and 154th Street from County Road 21 (Eagle Creek Avenue) will be required to be closed. The proposed detour for both streets will be along Grainwood Circle. All construction zones and detours will be properly signed.
