Overview

The City of Wabasha is undertaking a construction project to improve the pavement on 10th Street West, Arch Ave, Alleghany Ave, 8th Street West, Franklin Avenue, Jefferson Avenue, 12th Street East, Market Street East, Milligan Avenue, 9th Street East, Pierce Avenue, Augustin Avenue, Rustic Lane, and River Drive South.

The project will be very similar to the mill and overlay projects completed in 2014 and 2016 on the west side of town. The proposed improvements involve grinding up the existing asphalt and then placing a new layer of asphalt. The project will also involve replacement of existing asphalt curb, and localized spot repair of concrete curb.



Project Update

Rochester Sand and Gravel has finished milling and reclaiming the existing street pavement and the curb replacement and repair. There is still some driveway work that is yet to be completed.

They are expecting to begin paving starting the middle to end of the week of August 19th. Please be aware that during paving operations street traffic may be limited to one-way traffic and driveways may be inaccessible for a short period of time.

Underground utility work on Alleghany Avenue and 8th Street will tentatively begin the middle to end of the week of August 19th.
