Upcoming Work

Water and sanitary utilities will continue to be installed from 9th St. to 10th St. Storm sewer will be installed from 7th St. to 10th St. Sand and gravel will be placed from mid-block on 6th St. to 8th St. For residents that have had their lawns seeded, remember the permanent seed is just beginning to germinate, and will still take some time to grow in. There was a temporary seed planted to protect the soil from the weather until the permanent seed starts to grow. This temporary grass will die off over the winter, and the new permanent seed will continue to grow in next year. Please continue to let the grass grow without mowing it for at least another 2-3 weeks.
