Hwy 30 Construction Update

Now that the roadway is open to traffic, **please be cautious of workers on site** since various minor construction still remains. Over the next few weeks, workers will be on site intermittently to install pavement striping, construct concrete steps, and spraying mulch over exposed topsoil. On the west end of the project, crews will also be installing some guardrail. There are a few properties in downtown with missing downspouts; these will be reconnected soon.

Spring 2023 Work

If you had railing on steps that are being replaced with the project, the new railing will be installed next spring.

Although yards will be covered in mulch this year, yards in phase 2 will be re-seeded next spring. Please be patient with grass growth – the first year with new grass often involves bare spots and weed issues until the new grass is established and takes over. Your attention to regular watering and mowing will aid in this process.

Concrete Work

Wet concrete can sometimes be indistinguishable from dry concrete. As a best practice, **please do not walk on any concrete that you are seeing for the first time**. You may walk on concrete after 24 hours and drive after 7 days.

Garbage & Mail Pick-up

Garbage pick-up is back to normal. We are aware that several mailboxes were reinstalled in different locations than they were previously. Mailboxes will be relocated to the previous location soon.

End of Year Concerns

If you have any major concerns with the work performed in front of your home, **it is very important that you voice your concerns as soon as possible**. Waiting until after the contractor has left the project may result in no action taken. Please call one of the contacts listed in the left margin of this letter.
