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Phase 1 (Downtown) Construction

The following construction is planned over the next two weeks. **See the attached map.**

Mill St to Elm St

- Water and sewer services complete by June 3rd.
- Storm Sewer and street grading through middle of next week (~June 10).

Elm St to W Stevens Ave

- Set Up temporary water service (~June 6th).
- Start sanitary sewer and water main construction

Anticipated Impacts

Businesses between Elm Street and Hwy 43 will experience a short term water outage once normal underground water service is restored. The contractor will be contacting residents that need to connect to temporary water and may need to access your basement.

There may also be some short term private utility (electric, gas, internet/phone) impacts in the next two weeks as some of these utilities are relocated. When affected, you will be contacted

Once the contractor starts utility work between Elm St and Stevens Ave, this area will become less accessible for vehicles. Please plan accordingly.

Phase 2 (Residential) Area

Properties west of the Stevens Ave/Jessie Street intersection should not be severely impacted for several weeks. Some minor work may start; however, the street will be fully open to traffic.
