Phase 1 (Downtown) Construction

The following construction is planned over the next two weeks. See the attached map.

Mill St to Elm St

- Continued street grading and placement of sand/gravel base material
- Begin prepping for concrete curbs, walks, light pole locations

Elm St to W Stevens Ave

- Finish sanitary and water main construction
- Sanitary and water services
- Begin storm sewer installation

Anticipated Impacts

There are no new construction impacts for the next two weeks. Please continue to use side-streets and alleys for parking whenever possible. We appreciate your patience with this as we get through the most intrusive portion of street reconstruction

Residences/businesses between Elm and Stevens will continue to be connected to temporary water mains until the new mains and services are completely installed and tested (1-2 weeks remaining).

Phase 2 (Residential) Area

The <u>beginning of phase 2 work is now expected for mid-July</u>. The contractor will be allowed to start this area as soon as underground work (sewer and water) is installed and completely backfilled. As a reminder, there will be a period of time when the work will be active in both phase 1 and 2.

Residents will receive notice prior to starting work within Phase 2.

Holiday

The contractor will not be on site over the July 4th holiday weekend. If there are any special accommodations needed for businesses/residents, please contact Derek as soon as possible.
